## Re: Potential LEED v4 credits for projects using Floorazzo Tile.

To whom it may concern:

Many finishing products have the potential to contribute points to LEED v4, however the credits can only be gained when calculating the combined performance of all the products used on a particular LEED project; therefore, no single product can guarantee you will obtain LEED v4 credits.

The LEED v4 rating system promotes improved practices in the following credit categories:

- Location & Transportation
- Sustainable Sites
- Water Efficiency
- Energy & Atmosphere
- Materials & Resources
- Indoor Environmental

This letter is to confirm that Floorazzo Tile may contribute to the following LEED credits (points), based on LEED NCv4:

- v4 MRp2: Material and Resources – Construction and demolition waste management planning:
  - The tiles reduce waste from the installation process, thereby reducing waste in landfills.
- v4 MRc2: Material and Resources – Building product disclosure and optimization, environmental product declarations:
  - Option 1. Environmental product declaration (EPD) is in progress.
- v4 MRc3: Material and Resources – Building product disclosure and optimization, sourcing of raw materials:
  - Option 2. Sourcing of raw materials.
    - Recycled content. Recycled content for the Gem line is 18% post-consumer and 18% pre-consumer. The Marble line has 18% pre-consumer content.
- v4 EQc2: Indoor Environmental Quality – Low emitting materials:
  - Option 1 (Flooring). General emissions evaluation. Verified third party, meets CA 01350 requirements.
  - Option1 (Adhesives). Mapei Ultrabond ECO 373 is CRI Green Label Plus #GLP12617 certified and Living Building Challenge (LBC) Red List Free: This product has been verified per the most current Red List on the LBC Website.
  - Option 2. Budget Calculation Method.
